Museum to Reopen to the Public on Friday, October 16th

The Board of Directors and the Executive Director of the Bergstrom-Mahler Museum of Glass (BMMOG) are pleased to communicate that the museum will reopen to the public on Friday, Oct 16th, 2020. Closed temporarily due to a possible COVID -19 exposure on Oct 2nd, the test results came back negative. “Although we are delighted that the test results came back negative, we decided to keep our doors closed for the full 14 days of possible exposure out of concern for our visitors, volunteers, staff, and board. The time allowed us to review our COVID-19 protocols, revisit our 25% capacity limits, and sanitize areas of the museum,” says Amy Moorefield, the museum’s Executive Director. The BMMOG has and will continue use Center for Disease Control and Wisconsin Department of Health Services recommended guidelines and protocol to ensure the safety of our staff, volunteers, and visitors.
