PAUSE AND REBOOT: NEW IDEAS AT BERGSTROM-MAHLER MUSEUM OF GLASS

Along with a remarkable Board of Directors, a fantastic team of talented staff, and a large and generous corps of volunteers, it is my pleasure to ensure the future direction of our community's museum. You may hear me say the phrase "it's YOUR museum" a great deal and our museum truly is! First, established as a gift from Evangeline and John Nelson Bergstrom and later through the great works of Ernst and Carol Mahler and many, more special founding museum supporters including our partner the City of Neenah.

Our annual meeting and report have a long tradition, established in founding documents and in our by-laws in 1959 as a way to report to our members, sponsors and donors and also elect new officers to our board. We are honored to continue this tradition, 62 years running. The annual report and all that we do is in great part to celebrate YOU. We are so grateful for your time, enthusiasm, and generous hearts. A special note of thanks to Michael Meilahn, our outgoing Board President. His love of the museum and vision has been a great inspiration to me during my first year. I deeply thank him for his insight and guidance.

The pandemic gave us a great opportunity to pause and reboot the many ways we engage with our community. We have used our challenges to open up new doors for the museum. I am pleased to report that Bergstrom-Mahler was one of the only museums in the region that did not furlough or lay off our staff, through the generosity of our donors, and Covid-19 related grants.

The staff have been tireless heroes in crafting new initiatives, keeping a positive and creative attitude and, as a team, finding a way for the museum to be open safely (with reduced capacity and additional safety measures) since July 2nd, 2020. We are one of a handful of museums in the area – or the state, in fact – to maintain a regular opening schedule for the community.

When we have had Covid-19 related exposure concerns, we have closed following guidelines and have been transparent about it. I am proud of such a remarkable team and am grateful for their strong and resilient spirit which is reflected in innovative programs onsite and online. We had our first successful online auction, "Catching Fire" that supported both the museum and glass artists globally. In addition, we re-imagined our Art Activity Days and other major events.

We have an exciting year ahead with new special exhibitions and spotlights on our collection; hosting the Paperweight Collectors Association in May of 2021; a special offsite exhibition at the Paine Art Center and Gardens on our paperweights; our first Gala called The Crystal Ball; presenting an inaugural GLASS Festival; and our work on a new and vibrant strategic plan to inform our future work.

So, I invite you to come to Bergstrom-Mahler Museum of Glass, take a class, attend a talk, or participate in one of our many events this year. After all, you are an important part of our celebration of all things Glass.

A special thank you to outgoing board member, Marjorie Sutter, for sharing her knowledge of governance and her time. Her tenure was extensive as she was part of the team that selected the last 5 employees utilizing the employee selection process known as 15 Dots.

From time to time, we need to remind ourselves that we are growing our museum on a foundation built by individuals who love art. They gave not only financially, but conceptually as well. The driving force of the museum is the power of art itself. Personal interpretation of visual objects creates wonder and often settles in the subconscious, enriching our lives.

At the adjournment of the October Annual Meeting and Board of Directors meeting, my nine year tenure expires and Walt Koskinen will be your new president of the Board. As Bergstrom-Mahler Museum of Glass continues to grow its collection, clearly it is poised to move to a new level of prominence, with this prismatic, sparkling, colorful, fragile, translucent, and hot, sticky, sensual, fluid material called GLASS.





EXHIBITIONS

FORM AND FEELING – EXPRESSIONS OF HUMANITY

SEPTEMBER 01, 2020 – DECEMBER 31, 2020

This Richard L. Johnson memorial exhibition emphasizes the representation of human emotion and expression in figurative works of glass. Simultaneously strong and fragile, the glass pieces featured in this show draw a significant parallel to the condition of human feeling, be it pain, joy, anger, confusion, embarrassment, or a myriad of other emotions.

VICTORIAN GLASS BASKETS

OCTOBER 9, 2020 – JANUARY 14, 2021

During the reign of Alexandrina Victoria, Queen of Great Britain, Ireland, and Empress of India (1837-1901), English and American glass factories responded to the rise of consumerism and the increasing desire for everything glistening and ornamented by creating and marketing fanciful glass table decorations for middle and upper-class households. The art glass basket reached the height of its popularity between 1880 and 1890. These colorful and highly decorated works of art glass represent both ingenuity and technical skill. Frequently embellished with ruffled rims and applied handles shaped in loops or decorated with thorns, these baskets proved to be popular wedding gifts and were a mainstay in Victorian homes. Now on exhibit in the Mabel R. McClanahan Memorial Study Gallery.

DOCENTS KNOW GLASS

JANUARY 22 – MAY 16, 2021

Since our doors first opened in April, 1959, docents have played an integral role in sharing the story of Evangeline Bergstrom and her passion for collecting and expanding upon our knowledge of glass as an artistic medium. Through the efforts of docents past and present, visitors have gained a deeper understanding and appreciation for the time and expertise necessary to create works of glass art. Their continued enthusiasm and spirit of volunteerism exemplifies our vision for being The Place for Exciting Discoveries in Glass.

With combined docent experience totaling more than 75 years, our volunteer guides have selected works for exhibition from the permanent collection that are most significant to them. From antique paperweights and Germanic glass drinking vessels to Victorian baskets and contemporary glass sculpture, Docents Know Glass is sure to inspire an appreciation for everything Bergstrom-Mahler Museum of Glass has to offer – including our fantastic docents! This exhibition is curated by our current docent corps, including Liane Butitta, Gail Dolan, Chris Grunwald, Kay Hendrickson, Pat Rosenak, Mary Ellyn Vicksta and Jeff Zdrle., and is supported in part by the Richard L. Johnson Memorial Fund.

NEW ON VIEW

MAY 28 – AUGUST 22, 2021

Since 1959, Bergstrom-Mahler Museum of Glass has cultivated what has become the world's largest, most representative collection of glass paperweights on public display as well as a burgeoning contemporary studio glass collection. In 2011, the museum reaffirmed its commitment to glass by shifting its mission and collection focus to exclusively represent that medium.

A museum collection is its foundation. Following in the footsteps of founders Evangeline and John Nelson Bergstrom and Ernst and Carol Mahler, today's donors to the permanent collection recognize the importance of exhibiting, researching, and preserving works of glass for future generations. The museum's collection is evolving due to the many donors who have helped it grow through their generosity.

This exhibition showcases more than 200 acquisitions of paperweights and contemporary studio glass collected by Bergstrom-Mahler Museum of Glass during the past three years. A special highlight includes a significant selection of antique and contemporary glass paperweights from the collection of longtime supporters Gary and Marge McClanahan. New On View includes important works from artists such as Lisabeth Sterling, Marvin Lipofsky, Ken Rosenfeld, Debbie Tarsitano, and Marc Petrovic, many of which have never been publicly exhibited.

PROGRAMS, EDUCATION, AND THE COMMUNITY

THE GLASS STUDIO

The Glass Studio purchased 5 new Carlisle burners in fiscal year 2021, which are at least twice as big as our current bead making torches. This will give us the ability to make paperweights and other larger sculptures beginning in 2022. For years, The Glass Studio has been using plastic folding tables. We purchased custom tables from Carlisle with stainless steel surfaces. They have manifolds for the new and old torches directly underneath the table that eliminated the need for a large manifold bolted to a cart. These new manifolds have updated and new connections, making for safer equipment for our staff and students. We are grateful to the Walter Alexander Foundation for funding for our new torches and furniture.




We're very excited about the purchase of a new Mini Dragon and glass working bench from Mobile Glassblowing Studios LLC! Mini Dragons are a small, portable system that includes a glass furnace and glory hole (glass reheating chamber) all in one! It has "all terrain wheels" that will allow us to take it outside for demonstrations in the summer and also to take it to community events offsite. We are so appreciative to the Helen Hardt Family Fund within the Community Foundation of the Fox Valley Region for their generosity to purchase our Mini Dragon! One of our board members, Jon Clark, helped coordinate our purchase and we are grateful to Mobile Glassblowing Studios LLC for their generous in-kind support. Soon we will be able to make large paperweights and small blown glass objects.

THE FOX VALLEY AREA

HIGH SCHOOL GLASS EXHIBITION

The Fox Valley Area High School Glass Exhibition went on without being able to host our usual Glass Experience Days, where high schoolers come here on a field trip. With Covid protocols in place in the schools, field trips were not possible. Despite this obstacle, multiple schools were still able to produce work for our annual exhibition. 73 students participated and submitted work they made in their classes or independently. We are grateful to Richeson School of Art & Gallery.



ART ACTIVITY DAYS

Art Activity Days stayed alive with take home kits that were available for curbside pick-up or shipped. We developed a whole new national following with people who found comfort in having something new to do safely at home. It brought new people to the museum to pick up kits and also kept the studio in people's minds. We also are delighted to now offer Art Activity scholarships called "Golden Tickets" through the gracious support of an Education Grant from William and Helen Burger Memorial Fund within the Community Foundation of the Fox Valley Region. The Golden Ticket offers a child an opportunity to make an art activity at no charge.



SPARK!

The SPARK! programs turned virtual! By acquiring new camera equipment, The Glass Studio was able to host SPARK! online and also co-host multiple Memory Cafes through a partnership with the Fox Valley Memory Project. Partnering with a like-minded organization has enabled us to broaden our audience for the SPARK program. 


