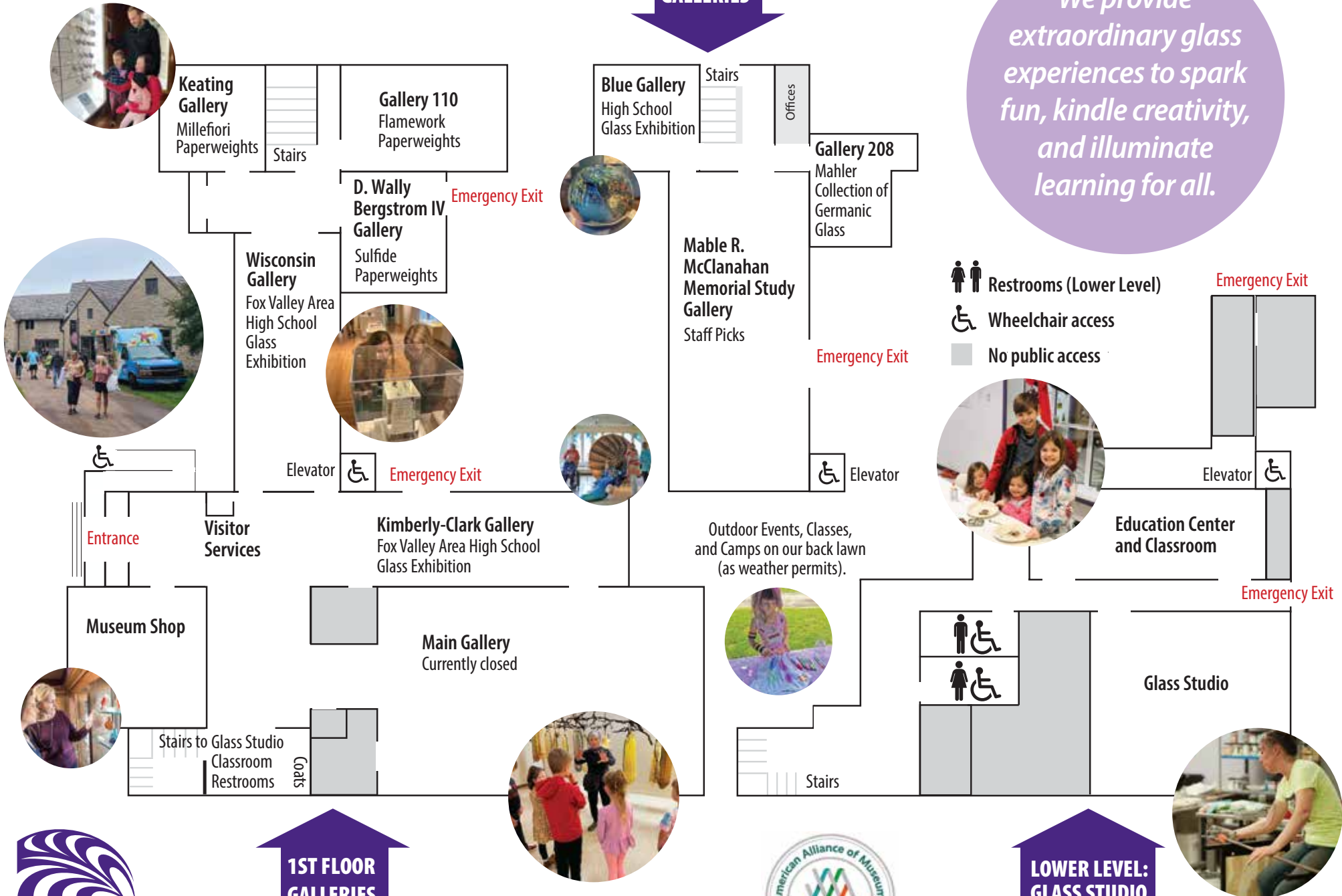

Bergstrom-Mahler Museum of Glass

The Tudor-style home built in 1930 as the private residence of John Nelson and Evangeline Bergstrom was established as a museum in 1959. Since 2012, it has operated exclusively as a glass art museum featuring nine galleries, a classroom, a glass studio, a museum shop and extensive grounds. With over 5,000 objects, the Museum's glass collection is known for containing the largest representative collection of antique to contemporary glass paperweights, the Mahler collection of Germanic vessels, Victorian Era decorative glass, and a significant collection of contemporary glass sculpture. Ranked in the top five glass museums in the country, it is the only glass museum in Wisconsin, and is nationally accredited by the American Alliance of Museums.

The Museum is located on the shores of Lake Winnebago at 165 North Park Avenue in Neenah, Wisconsin.
